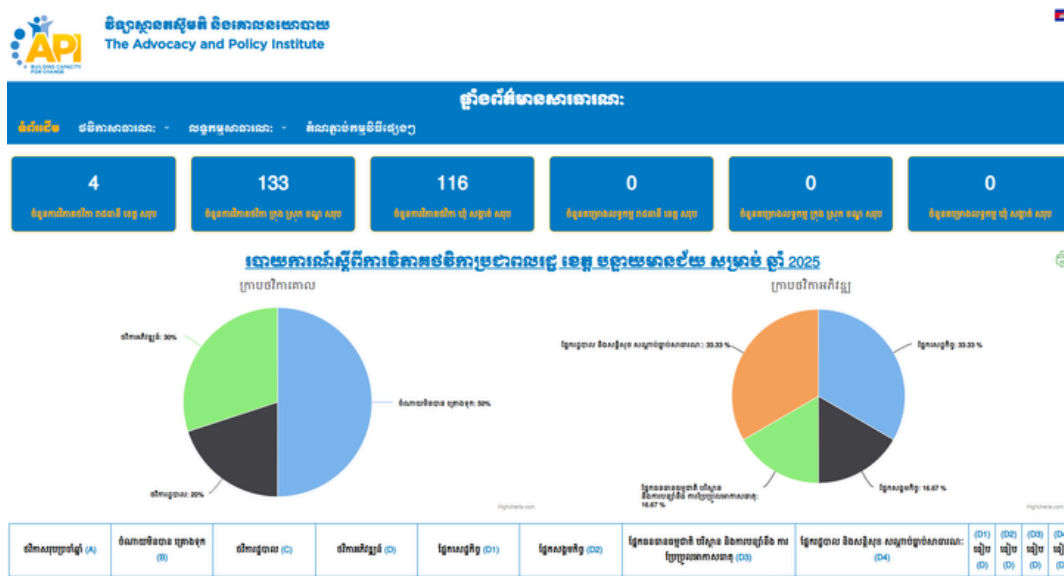




# Citizen Budget App

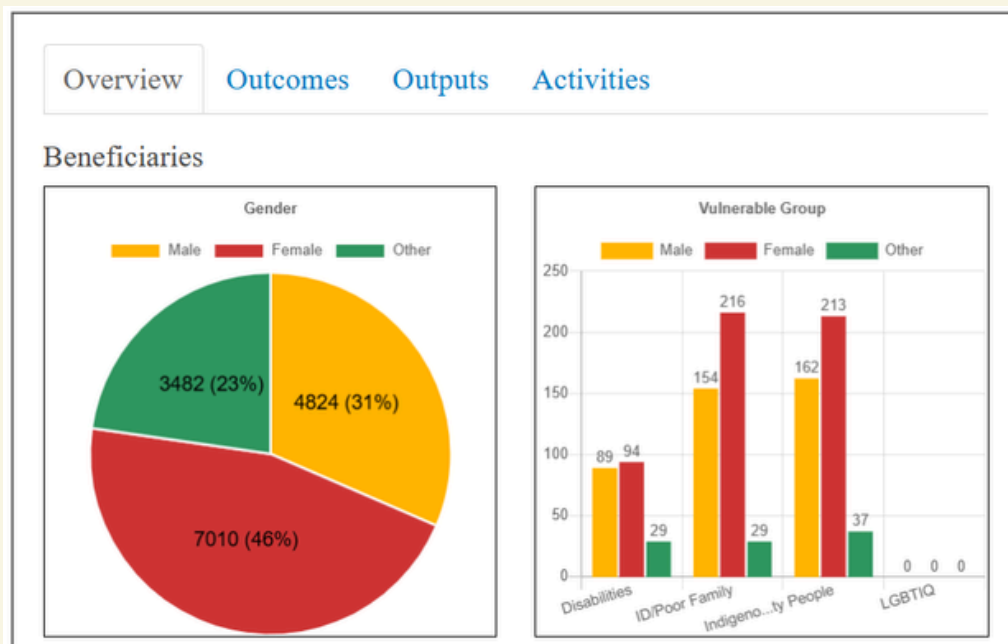

## WaterAid's CLIMB CSOs Project

Civil society leadership in mobilizing for better WASH (CLIMB)—strengthens local civil society leadership to advance inclusive, climate-resilient, and gender-responsive WASH services in health care facilities (HCFs) in Cambodia. The project focuses on building the advocacy and influencing capacity of local CSOs, supporting evidence generation and citizen engagement, and promoting effective social accountability mechanisms (e.g., community monitoring and joint action planning) to improve service quality. By linking community feedback with structured dialogue among CSOs, health facilities, and sub-national health authorities, CLIMB contributes to stronger accountability, better planning and implementation of WASH improvements, and increased commitment and investment for sustainable WASH in HCFs.
